Community Park Day – Help Needed

September 21st is community park day. All of our parks need to get some work done and we are asking residents of the community to help get it done. If you can make it here is what we need to get done (starting at 9:00 Saturday morning):

1. Plant a memorial garden at Werner Park for Rosalie (see details later in this section.)
2. Build a wheelchair accessible boardwalk around the playground at Werner Park (Barry Swift will be organizing.) We need people to bring their hammers, saws, etc. to help with this.
3. Build a wheelchair accessible deck around the building at Bennett Park (Murray Mason will be organizing.) Bring your toolbox for this one too.
4. Chip up brush at Werner Park and Middle Park (chipper will need to be moved around.)
5. Spread the chips on the trail at Middle Park (gravel too.) Use the chips as

mulch for gardens and plants at Werner Park. Spread the chips at Bennett Park as well.

6. Possibly install playground equipment at Bennett Park (if the area is ready and we can get concrete on a Saturday.)
7. Possibly plant some trees and shrubs at Bennett Park.

On Friday night (20th) we will chip up the brush at Bennett Park (piled in the driveway) starting at approximately 6:00.

We will provide hot dogs and pop for volunteers. Feel free to show up at the park that most interests you (if we have too many in one area we may have to ask people to go to another park.)

Here is a wish list in regards to the garden from Clare O'Brien and Sandy Mason:

Cuttings from gardens: we need any **sun-loving** perennials; tulips; daffodils.

Trees: we have 2 donations of rhododendrons already. A 3rd or even 4th would be great; maples or pines;

hydrangea for autumn colour. We have a number of rugosa roses that may have to wait until spring to go in (They could also go around the outskirts of this park).

Garden Supplements: we will need manure, compost, mulch, fertilizer (in the spring).

Small brass plaque or wooden sign: this will have Rosalie's name and a short sentiment that will sum up what she meant to many children of this community. It would be nice to have a couple of homemade/child crafted garden ornaments, but I worry about theft or vandalism (the telescope has already been stolen). A large painted rock here and there in the garden might suffice. Rosalie would have liked the simple option.

As you know, if the plants are in deep soil with a good amount of mulch on top, and are well-watered at planting time, we will not have to worry about watering thru the summer. Sandy and I will do upkeep and fertilizing in the spring.
